REGULATED RATE OPTION



The RRO may increase or decrease from month to month as it is priced on the open market and subject to many factors relating to supply and demand. It is not a 'regulated' rate, rather it is a default rate. If you do not have an energy contract, then you are on the RRO.

For January 2024, the RRO is priced at \$0.13968 per kWh, reflected on your enclosed blue bill. For February 2024, the REA monthly rate as calculated under the RRO regulation is \$0.14807. Detailed information on the monthly RRO is available on: www.brpower.coop.
