We've introduced a new Residential Rate that could mean an average 41% savings for eligible members that are currently on a fixed Distribution Tariff (DT) rate.

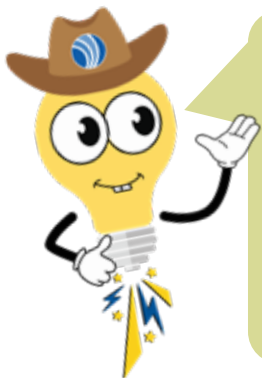
Don't wait! We accept 50 applications per month on a first-come, first-served basis.

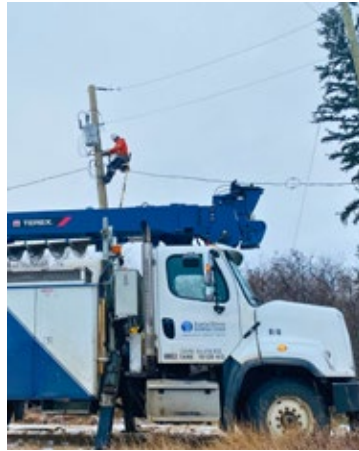

What is our crew UP to?

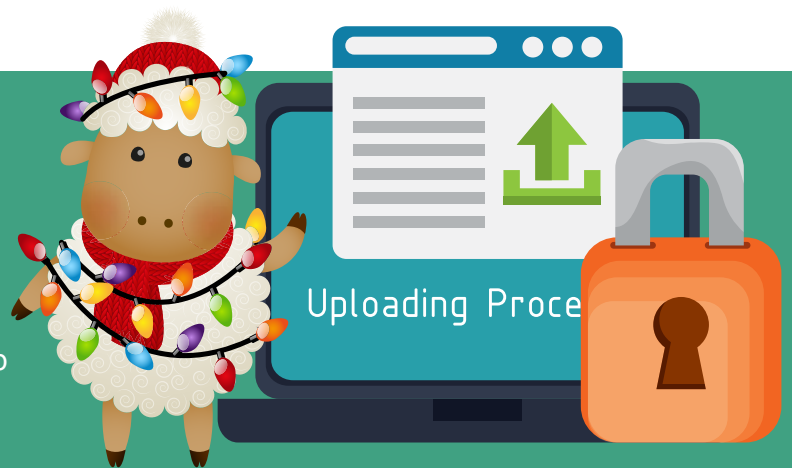
Here's a look at a day in the life of one of our service crews. They're completing a system voltage conversion by upgrading the infrastructure and replacing the transformers from 8KV to 14.4KV. This is done to improve system reliability and efficiency of the electrical system.

Shop Smart, Stay Safe Online

Shopping online is convenient, but it's also a favourite playground for scammers. A few simple habits can help keep your personal information and money safe.



Start with the basics:

Always shop on trusted websites. Look for the padlock symbol and "https" in the address bar; this means the site is secure. If a deal looks too good to be true, it probably is. tAvoid posting personal details like full birth dates or home addresses.

Watch out for fake stores:

Scammers often create convincing websites that disappear after taking your payment. Stick to retailers you know, and if you're trying a new site, do a quick search for reviews before buying.

Protect your payment info:

Avoid using debit cards online. Credit cards or secure payment services like PayPal offer better fraud protection. And never save your card details on a public or shared device.

Finally, keep an eye on your bank statements.

Spotting unusual charges early can prevent bigger headaches later.
