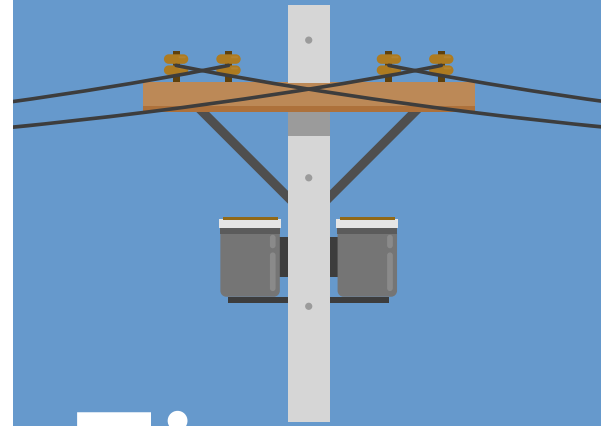

Tips from the Line

What should you do if you are in a vehicular accident with a power pole?

1

Stay in the car after an accident with a power pole. **ONLY** vacate the vehicle if it is on fire.

2

Warn those who try to come near your car to help that they must stay far away.

3

Call 911 for help, and wait until a professional from the electric utility tells you it is safe to leave the car.

Battle River Scholarship Application



Deadline for Applications is Friday, February 10, 2023

Annually Battle River Power Coop makes five scholarships of \$1000.00 available for dependents of Battle River Power Coop members.

If you are interested in applying for one of the five scholarship grants, you can obtain complete information on the scholarship criterion and download the application by visiting our website: www.brpower.coop/community/scholarships.

The scholarship application outlines the eligibility requirements including, but not limited to, details on the program of study, confirmed registration in the program, tuition payment confirmation, reference letter and applicant letter outlining their community involvement and why financial assistance is needed.

REGULATED RATE OPTION



The RRO may increase or decrease from month to month as it is priced on the open market and subject to many factors relating to supply and demand. It is not a 'regulated' rate, rather it is a default rate. If you do not have an energy contract, then you are on the RRO.

For November 2022, the RRO is priced at \$0.18331 per kWh, reflected on your enclosed blue bill. For December 2022, the REA monthly rate as calculated under the RRO regulation is \$0.24598. Detailed information on the monthly RRO is available on: www.brpower.coop.

The Battle River Rural Energy Contract rate is \$0.0635 per kWh until December 31, 2023.

Members are free to purchase natural gas services or electricity services from a retailer of their choice. For a list of retailers, visit ucahelps.alberta.ca or call 310-4822 (toll free in Alberta).
